

Focal Points of Student's Moral Conduct Conversion in National University of Kaohsiung

The 27th Student Affairs meeting passed on December 26, 2014.

- I. To provide the students with the application for the off-campus scholarships or other requirements, the Student Affairs Council stipulates “Focal Points of Student's Moral Conduct Conversion in National University of Kaohsiung.”
- II. The basic score is 85% with a maximum of 95%. The final score is added with or reduced by rewards and penalties respectively.
- III. The following are the regulations of addition and reduction of moral conduct.
 - (i.) Adding one remark for commendation; two and half remarks for merit; seven and half remarks for great merit.
 - (ii.) Reducing one remark for reprimand; two and half remarks for peccadillo; seven and half remarks for serious offense.
- IV. The evaluation method of moral conduct is below:
 - (i.) 95% or more is converted into A+.
 - (ii.) 85% more and less than 90% is converted into A.
 - (iii.) 80% more and less than 85% is converted into A-.
 - (iv.) 70% more and less than 80% is converted into B.
 - (v.) 60% more and less than 70% is converted into C.
 - (vi.) Less than 60% is converted into D
- V. The certificate is dispatched when the students apply for it.
- VI. The focal points are passed by the Student Affairs and will be announced after the president calibrates and ratifies.
