

Hsu Po Yih Need-based and Merit-based Scholarship Application Procedures

Passed by the 2013 Academic Year's 1st Student Financial Assistance Management Committee Meeting on December 30, 2013

Article 1. To encourage the students at National University of Kaohsiung (hereinafter referred to as "this school) to successfully complete their education with their best study effort, Mr. Hsu Po Yih established *the Hsu Po Yih's Need-based and Merit-based Scholarships*, and the application procedures (hereinafter referred to as "the Procedures") are as follows.

Article 2. Eligible Applicants and Scholarship Amount:

1. Students (hereinafter referred to as "Mainland Students") admitted to undergraduate and graduate schools by this school via *University Entrance Committee for Mainland Chinese Students* are eligible:
 - (1) Graduate students: Supporting academically exceptional Mainland Students' tuition and other miscellaneous expenses of their first year of studies, for at most 5 students.
 - (2) Undergraduate students: Supporting academically exceptional Mainland Students with NT\$ 25,000 per semester, for at most 5 students.
2. Current students from medium-and-low income, low-income families, or families encountering sudden dramatic hardships, who desperately require assistance, may apply for this need-based scholarship. The amount is adjusted flexibly every year based on the funding available, and is NT\$ 10,000 per student in principle.

Article 3. Application Time

1. Merit-based Scholarship: In concert with the Division of Academic Affairs' Mainland Student recruiting; automatically applied on their behalf upon their enrollment.
2. Need-based Scholarship: The application is open within one month after the semester begins. The exact duration is announced separately.

Article 4. Documents required

1. Merit-based Scholarship: Same as the documents required by the department/graduate institute.

2. Need-based Scholarship: Application form and the following documents are required:
 - (1) Medium-and-low income, low-income household certification or other relevant evidence;
 - (2) Certificate of Enrollment;
 - (3) Freshmen need to attach entrance exam scores; other students need to attach the academic record of the previous semester.

Article 5. Granting Principle:

1. The awarded students may only receive the scholarship after completing the semester's registration;
2. Scholarship is given on a monthly basis.
3. If an awarded student leaves the school with his or her student status retained, suspends the schooling, or is expelled from this school, the originally approved scholarship will be cancelled.
4. If an awarded student forges or provides false information and this is proven, the scholarship payment will be suspended, and the already paid amount is to be returned.

Article 6. Approval Process: After approval by the Scholarship Review Committee at the Division of Students Affairs, it is submitted to the Student Financial Assistance Management Committee for subsequent confirmation.

Article 7. These Procedures are passed by the Student Financial Assistance Management Committee, and then promulgated after being approved by the President. The same procedures shall apply to amendments which may arise. These Procedures are effective immediately upon promulgation.
